Nature of sustainability 2013/14

The school invested last year in the recruitment of a PE apprentice as well as enhancing the range of sports we offer by purchasing new equipment. The recruitment of a PE apprentice has meant that more time is spent on the teaching and learning of PE and less time has to be spent on preparation by teaching staff of equipment.

Hockey has now been added to the repertoire of sports offered by the school.



Curriculum focus of sports fund spending 2014/15

The main curriculum focus for 2014/15, after the reimbursement of the PE apprentice is to introduce real PE into the school, so that the teachers and pupils all undertake a new way of learning PE and how it can impact on the learning behaviours in the classroom.
