The Wizard of Oz

In this topic the children will share extracts from the Wizard of Oz. They will present their own weather forecast and research extreme weather patterns. They will also write their own version of the story.

New vocabulary we will learn:

tornado- a type of storm in which powerful rotating winds form a column, which reaches from a cloud down toward the ground.

weather- the state of the atmosphere in terms of wind, temperature, cloudiness, moisture or air pressure.

weather forecast- a prediction of the weather in an area with an assessment of likely developments.

thunder- a loud rumbling or crashing noise heard after a lightning flash due to the expansion of rapidly heated air.

lightning- the flashing of light caused by the passing of electricity from one cloud to another or between a cloud and the earth.
