View and compare art by Andy Goldsworthy, Guiseppe Arcimboldo and Salvador Dali.

Look at how they construct their pieces and the materials they use.

Use a range of art techniques to create our own pieces.

Visit Rugby art gallery or the sculpture park at Warwick University.

Eat some Spanish, Italian or Scottish food.

Learn a few words in Italian, Spanish or Scottish Gaelic.

## Texts that you could read at home...

Truckers by Terry Pratchett

How to train your dragon by Cressida Cowell

A non fiction book about any of the artists or countries we are studying.

In this topic the children will learn about how three different European artists used their imagination to turn unusual resources into works of art.

They will read books based on imaginary worlds, learn about the places the artists are from and have a go at creating their own masterpieces.

## New vocabulary we will learn:

**Physical geography** - the study of the natural features on Earth.

**Human geography** - the study of man made features on Earth.

**Medium** - a material an artist uses e.g. paint or chalk.

**Sculpture** - a work of art that is a solid figure or object

**Tone** - a shade of a colour

**Shade** - how dark or light a colour is.
