In this topic the children will learn about the Roman invasion and how the Romans affected Great Britain. They will also learn about the British resistance to the Roman invasion.

New vocabulary we will learn:

Empire: A group of countries which are ruled over by one person.

Invasion: When someone attempts to enter a location and take it over.

Resistance: Trying not to let someone take over a location.

Ampitheatre: An open area surrounded by tiers of seats, used to present dramatic events.

Aqueduct: A man made channel of water, typically in the form of a bridge.

Mythology: A collection of myths belonging to one culture.
