Dear Parents/Carers and Pupils

Well the time has come for us to administer SATs again and this will happen next week – Monday 9 May to Friday 13 May. The test dates are set by the government and the conditions and arrangements under which they are run are strictly to ensure confidentiality.

We are hoping that all children will be well and have their opportunity to shine, but if they are poorly, keep in touch as we can apply for timetable variations of upto 5 days.

The tests are:

Monday 9 May – Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – Papers 1 & 2

Tuesday 10 May – Reading

Wednesday 11 May – Maths Papers 1 & 2

Thursday 12 May – Maths Paper 3

Friday 13 May – Science

All of the tests take place in the mornings, which is why we offer breakfast club, so there is a calm start to the day.

For some pupils they will sit their papers in different rooms to their classmates and this is because they qualify for additional time or need a reader or scribe in certain tests. We will be running 7 different rooms which involves 18 staff – quite a challenge, so as long as there is no staff absence all will be well.
