Nut Free and Sesame Seed Free Zone: Paddox is a NUT FREE and SESAME SEED FREE ZONE. We have an increasing number of children with severe allergies to nuts and sesame seeds so we do not allow these items in school at all. This includes nut based spreads like peanut butter and Nutella and Nutella snacks. Please make sure that your child is not bringing nut based products or sesame seeds to school in their lunch boxes.

Healthy School: We are striving to be a healthy school. Please ensure that any snacks brought into school are in keeping with this aim. We are seeing an increase in the number of chocolate bars and crisps that children are bringing in to school.


