To celebrate, the children will have themed assemblies, classroom activities and the chance to make meaningful connections with others!





### **Important Reminders**



**Dinner money:** Please make sure dinner money is paid in advance by the Monday of each week. Meals cost £2.30 per meal or £11.50 per week, payable via Pay 360 Education Payments (or cash payment to the school office). If you are unable to login to Pay 360 please email

*Illness:* Please remember if your child vomits or has diarrhoea, they cannot return to school for a *full 48 hours* from the last time your child vomited / had diarrhoea.

*Medical appointments during the school day:* If your child needs to attend a medical appointment during the school day please email both your child's class teacher and the school office

(admin2625@welearn365.com<sup>4</sup>) as to who is collecting your child, what time and the reason for the appointment. Where possible please try to arrange appointments out of school hours.

**Medication:** No medication should come into school without prior arrangement and necessary form(s) being completed via the school office only. Children should **not** have any medication in their school bags or on their person in school.

*Water bottles:* Please ensure your child comes to school with a named water bottle every day. The bottle should only contain water (not squash or other drinks). We are unable to provide children with spare bottles or cups.
