Subject overviews – timetables are on the website, it should prompt conversations at home. On the website we have updated the curriculum pages. We are trying to make sure everything is important. Staffing – if people are off we plan people in advance, however if someone is off unplanned it is harder to cover at such short notice, which is when we have to rely on supply cover. PE sessions – we have spoken about them being missed with staff and hopefully it is not happening anymore. Behaviour chart – this is under review. We are talking about whether the trees have a good impact. There will be more coming soon as we want parent voice. Surgery after school – we are looking into it. School council – We want new people to have a chance each year so it isn't always the same people. Orchard booking – should be easier to use and help us with staffing. We have now said that parents have to book in advance. Booking more flexibly incurs higher costs but supports staffing better. Playground equipment – a box has been provided for the children to use. The Year 5 now have moved to the main playground, which means now Year 6 have more space. Library Club – Not started it yet. We are hoping to use the guad as a quiet space for the children to access if they do not want to go outside. This will be by invite only, initially. This is a comfortable calm space and rules will be in place. Year 6 – we have been given information about Mocks. World Book Day was also moved so Year 6 could join in. The children loved it. Well Done Ashleigh Merrick. Class instead of Tree name – This has changed now, so emails are now saying Year group. Communication Apps – Lots of parents have asked why can we not have all the SA/KG information in one place. We are such a big primary school – we are probably more of a small secondary school. We are looking into introducing a school app. SchoolApp Shows messages relevant to you. You can filter stuff if you want to. Home screen will show important dates. You can save dates to your calendar. Information about the school on the main page. Bottom tab (home, content, calendar, messages, profile)

Sometimes people update their details but forget to let us know. This app will allow parents/carers to change details easily– this will then update us so we know of any changes.

We can suspend people if we need to stop them gaining access to the app.

We haven't decided on the attendance side.
We won't be using the app for behaviour.

We will try and use it after Easter, but not fully. The plan to use it full time will hopefully be by June. But we are learning how to use it. Therefore, it will be gradually introduced.

This provider will help us change our website and update it where necessary. The website will look very similar to the app.

DOJO - It is very new.

We don't want to jump into everything. We have set up the profiles. Now we are making learning more visual. Class Dojo does have a behaviour system, we are hoping to link that to our school rules/ethos. We know consistency is very important, we are going steady and trying to use it right. We do want to come back to asking for photo permission. We want to use photographs with faces on Class Dojo. We love the joy you see in their faces is lovely to see, so why do why hide this. Parents are happy with Class Dojo.

Snow Day – System went down, this was not our fault. We did decide the conditions in Rugby were not good. Staff were asked, if they can send resources home. If we had more than 24 hours of snow, we may have to look into online learning, but 24 hours is not enough time to prep and change things by a class teacher.

Children in Year 2, concerned about spelling, how can they be helped? – Will talk to Year 2 teachers Mixing classes – We are looking to mix the classes. We would make sure that was done correct using the correct transition period. We want a balance of ability, SEND and personality. (Year 2 probably will happen) (Year 4, again may happen).
